Programme: The theme of the conference will be dealt with during workshops, an expert lecture panel, an excursion to the new memorial in Lety and the cemetery in Mirovice, a film screening and discussions, for example with Růžena Ďordňová, whose words are used as the motto of the conference, and Jana Kokyova, a Chairwoman of the Committee for the Redress of the Roma Holocaust in the Czech Republic. We want to offer participants an open environment in which they will be able to gain new knowledge on the topic, participate in discussions and reflect their ideas. We also offer them an opportunity to use the acquired knowledge in their schools afterwards.

The conference is held under the auspices of Lucie Fuková, the Government Commissioner for Roma Minority Affairs.
